

You have decided to donate a cow, congratulations! We are very happy that you are contributing to the livestock of Floating Farm. Please read the points of attention and then you will be ready to welcome your cow during the opening at the Floating Farm!

Points of attention:

- Super innovative indeed, a farm with cows on the water. Your donation gives you the unique opportunity to be involved in our beautiful project. As a contribution we ask € 1,500.-, which is the cost of a MRIJ (Maas Rijn IJssel) cow for us. Please think it through, as no refund will be possible once you have donated. You can read all about this Old Dutch cow breed on our website.
- The next point to consider is that you may come up with a nice name for the cow yourself. You may know a nice Old Dutch cow name or maybe you will approach it from an entirely different angle!
- Once the Floating Farm is ready for production and the cows are in their new barn, it is obviously time to get to know the cow. Farmer Albert will be glad to show you which cow you have donated and of course we will also make some nice pictures and selfies of you and the cow.
- You will also receive an invitation for the official opening of Floating Farm and once every year a special event will be organized for you and the other cow-donors (we should obviously organize some sort of celebrations for the cows' birthdays 😊).
- If you donate a cow, the animal becomes property of Floating Farm. The Floating Farm therefore has control over the daily care of the cow donated by you. Farmer Albert cares deeply about animals, so we are certain that he will do everything he can to give the cow that you donated a great life at the Floating Farm!
- Of course you are welcome to visit your donated cow (please do so during opening hours, as that is most convenient). Hence you can always come and have a look and show your friends and family how the cow is doing.
- The fact that the cow is owned by Floating Farm does not only imply that farmer Albert is in charge of taking care of the cow, but also that the cow's yield (in dairy, manure, calves and eventually meat) will go to Floating Farm. In all fairness, we must also earn our living with this.
- And well, you may not want to think about it, but one day the cow will no longer be able to stay at the Floating Farm. This situation may occur due to illness, old age, because the cow is no longer in-calf (she can no longer have calves) or because the production reduces in such a way that we are no longer able to maintain the cow. When that moment arrives, the cow will be slaughtered to be sold as meat. If now you are thinking: no, I really do not want that! Then you may also choose to bring the cow to a cow rest-home. There she can enjoy her old age in a pleasant way. **Please note:** Floating Farm itself has no connections with rest-homes, so the donor itself will have to arrange and finance the stay at a rest-home. - As a final point of attention, we are dealing with the new privacy legislation. That may sound boring or unimportant, but it certainly is not! If you wish to donate a cow, we will need your permission to store your personal data. For us it is important to know your name and contact details so that we can invite you to the opening of the Floating Farm

and the other fun events for donors! Moreover, it is also useful to know who you are in case you want to visit the cow and of course for the photo opportunity. Therefore, please fill out the donation form immediately, so that all the information can be orderly kept. If you prefer not to do this, please send an e-mail so that we at least have the e-mail address of the generous donor. We also need permission to store your cow picture so that we can send it to you afterwards.
